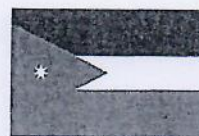

PREAMBLE

This Addendum No. 2 (comprising seven pages, including the cover page) forms an integral part of the **Request for Qualification (RFQ)** for the Construction of the National Conveyor Project Readiness Infrastructure – Bulks 1, 2 and 6 Tender No. 2/SW/2026.

This addendum modifies the RFQ documents and may add, delete, revise, or replace provisions of the said RFQ document, including those contained in addendum No. 1 issued on July 23, 2026. In the event of any inconsistency between this Addendum and the RFQ Documents previously issued, the provisions of this Addendum shall prevail with respect to the matters addressed herein.

This addendum comprised of two parts: Part 1 includes responses to clarifications received from applicants, and Part 2 amends the qualification criteria.

PART I – RESPONSES TO BIDDERS' CLARIFICATION REQUESTS

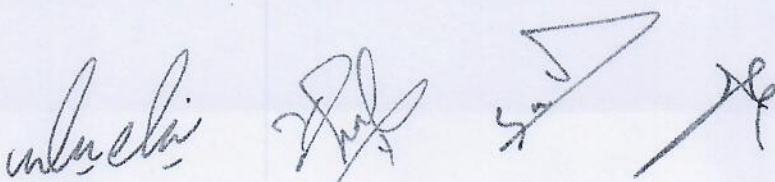
This part provides responses to the bidders' clarification requests.

Question 1: Part I-Prequalification Procedures, Section I: Instructions to Applicants, ITA no. 4.4 (c), it is stated that *(The Applicant, including any subcontractor, shall not be associated or have had a business relationship with, nor have been associated or have had a business relationship with the Consultants, CDM International Inc., or the parent firm CDM Smith Inc., Sajdi-Consulting Engineering Center, and their subcontractors Engicon, Dar Al Handasah, and Orient in the preparation of the design, specifications, and bidding documents for the NCP Readiness Infrastructure Project. Any such association or business relationship will result in the rejection of the Application. The Applicant shall submit a statement certifying it has not had any such association or business relationship that would constitute a conflict of interest).*

Please confirm that the above-mentioned statement is not applicable for the subject Tender, as our understanding that the Contract will be executed under the FIDIC Red Book.

Answer 1: The requirements in the referenced ITB stand regardless of the type of FIDIC book used in the project. The wording is revised in Part II of this addendum to clarify ITA no. 4.4 (c).

Question 2: Please note that we intend to apply for all three Bulks (Bulk 1, Bulk 2 and Bulk 6). Should we submit a separate, complete and standalone prequalification application for each Bulk (i.e., three independent submissions), or a single combined application covering all three Bulks?



Answer 2: Applicants intending to apply for more than one Bulk, including Bulks 1, 2, and 6, may submit a single prequalification application covering all intended Bulks. Separate standalone submissions for each Bulk are not required.

The application shall clearly identify the Bulk(s) for which prequalification is sought and shall clearly distinguish between information and supporting documentation that are common to all Bulks and those that are specific to a particular Bulk. Where qualification requirements vary by Bulk, the Applicant shall provide the relevant information and documentation demonstrating compliance with the requirements of each applicable Bulk.

Question 3: *Section III – Qualification Criteria and Requirements (and the Invitation for Prequalification) states that each Applicant cannot be awarded more than two Bulks. Kindly confirm that an Applicant is permitted to apply for and be prequalified for all three Bulks, and that the limitation of a maximum of two Bulks applies only at the contract award stage.*

Answer 3: Confirmed

Question 4: *Under the Specific Construction Experience criterion (Sub-Factor 7.2.1 for Bulk 1, 8.2.1 for Bulk 2, and 9.2.1 for Bulk 6), the RFQ requires a minimum of two (2) similar projects, each meeting the specified minimum value, and states that each project "should include as a minimum" the listed sub-requirements (items a, b, c, d, etc.).*

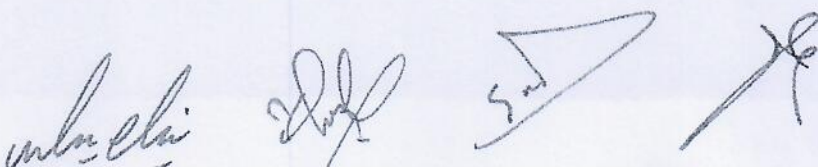
Kindly clarify whether all of the listed sub-requirements must be demonstrated within a single project, or whether the Applicant may satisfy these sub-requirements collectively across multiple projects. It is often challenging to identify a single project that encompasses all of the required scopes of work.

Answer 4: The sub-requirements listed are not required to be demonstrated through the same project. Applicants may rely on multiple projects to satisfy the various sub-requirements, provided that each referenced project falls within the specified timeframe and individually meets the minimum required contract value.

Applicants are advised to carefully review the amendments to the Qualification Criteria set out in all issued addenda, and to ensure that their applications demonstrate compliance with the revised requirements as applicable.

Question 5: *Furthermore, should separate applications be required for each Bulk, we would kindly request your consideration to reduce the required number of hard copies to **one (1) original and one (1) copy** for each application, instead of the current requirement stated below:*

"In addition to the original hard and soft copy, the number of copies to be submitted with the Application includes two (2) hard and soft copies."



This would help minimize unnecessary printing and administrative effort while maintaining the integrity of the submission process.

We appreciate your clarification and consideration and look forward to your response.

Answer 5: Please refer to answer No. 2 above. There is no change to the number of copies required.

Question 6: In "Section III. Qualification Criteria and Requirements for Bulk 1." – 7. Experience. 7.2 Specific Construction Experience: it is stated that "7.2.2 Installation of one additional project of a minimum value of \$8 million that includes 10 km or more of 400 mm diameter of water/wastewater pressurized pipeline installed in Jordan."

Please confirm acceptance of: Submitting a project, executed in Jordan during the last 20 years or more

Answer 6: Please adhere to the RFQ requirement

Question 7: In "Section III. Qualification Criteria and Requirements for Bulk 2." – 8. Experience. 8.2 Specific Construction Experience: it is stated that "8.2.2 Installation of one additional project of a minimum value of \$8 million that includes 10 km or more of 400 mm diameter of water/wastewater pressurized pipeline installed in Jordan."

Please confirm acceptance of: Submitting a project, executed in Jordan during the last 20 years or more

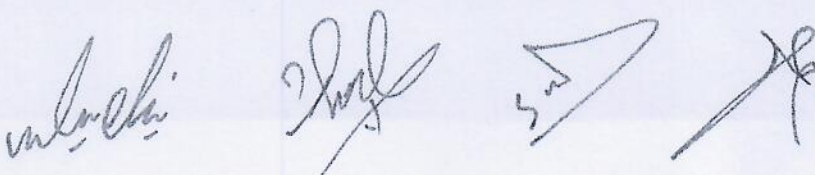
Answer 7: Please adhere to the RFQ requirement

PART II – RFQ MODIFICATIONS

The followings revised and/or provided additional information to Applicants:

- **Part 1 - Prequalification Procedures, Section I: Instructions to Applicants, ITA 4.4(c), replace the paragraph with the following paragraph:**

Any Applicant, including any subcontractor, will be subject to Prequalification Application rejection for a given bulk if they are or have been involved in the preparation of the design, specifications, and/or bidding documents for the NCP Readiness Infrastructure Project Bulk 1, Bulk 2, and/or Bulk 6 while in association with or in a business relationship with CDM International Inc (also referred to as CDM Smith), Sajdi-Consulting Engineering Center, and their subcontractors Engicon, Dar Al Handasah, and Orient. The Applicant shall submit a statement certifying it has not had any such association or business relationship that would constitute a conflict of interest relative to the development of these design packages.



▪ **Extension of the Application submission deadline:**

The deadline for the submission of Applications set forth in in the “**Specific Procurement Notice-Invitation for Prequalification**” is extended until September 6, 2026. Applications shall be submitted at the same location and no later than the same time specified in the Invitation for Prequalification.

▪ **Section III Qualification Criteria and Requirements**

The qualification criteria and requirements provided in addendum no.1 dated July 23, 2026, are modified as follows:

A. The Table on Qualification Criteria and Requirements for Bulk 1:

The Specific Construction Experience requirements set out in section 7.2.1 of Addendum No. 1 are hereby revised as set forth below:

A minimum of two (2) similar projects that have been satisfactorily completed as a prime contractor, joint venture member, or sub-contractor in the last fifteen (15) years, each with a minimum value of USD 8,000,000 (USD). This should include as a minimum

- a. One project with the installation of at least 2 km of 600 mm diameter or more of pressurized welded steel pipelines. Project shall be at least 70% complete.
- b. One project with the installation of at least 5 km of pressurized ductile iron pipelines of 400mm diameter or more
- c. Construction of one trenchless pipeline installation with diameters of 600 mm or larger and at least 50m long (specialized subcontractor is acceptable).
- d. Construction of at least one reinforced concrete water retaining structure of a capacity of 5000 m3 or more.

Other criteria remain the same.

B. Table on Qualification Criteria and Requirements for Bulk 2:

The Specific Construction Experience requirements set out in section 8.2.1 of Addendum No. 1 are hereby revised as set forth below:

A minimum of two (2) similar projects that have been satisfactorily completed as a prime contractor, joint venture member, or sub-contractor in the last fifteen (15) years, each with a minimum value of USD 8,000,000 (USD). This should include as a minimum

- a. One project with the installation of at least 2 km of 600 mm diameter or more of pressurized welded steel pipelines. Project shall be at least 70% complete.
- b. One project with the installation of at least 5 km of pressurized ductile iron pipelines of 400mm diameter or more
- c. Construction of one trenchless pipeline installation with diameters of 600 mm or larger and at least 50m long (specialized subcontractor is acceptable).
- d. Construction of at least one reinforced concrete water retaining structure of a capacity of 5000 m³ or more.
- e. Construction of a pump station.

Other criteria remain the same.
